ANDREW M. ALLISON

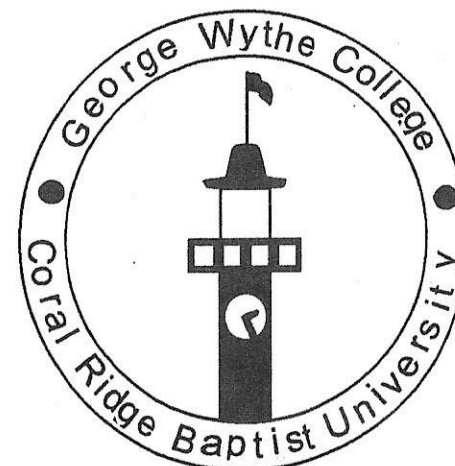
